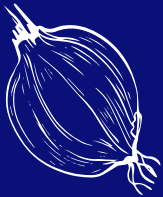
Barn Work Day

Greenhand Camp

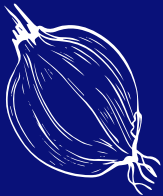

- Orders arrive: Before Thanksgiving Break

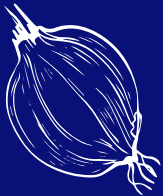
Ag Teacher Holiday Hours

DO NOT CONTACT UNLESS AN EMERGENCY

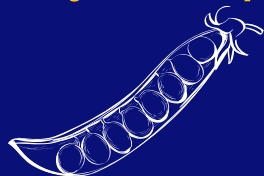
Ex: barn is on fire (CALL 911 FIRST)

skirts to be no more than 2 inches**

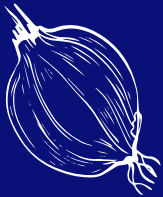

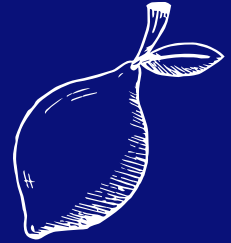

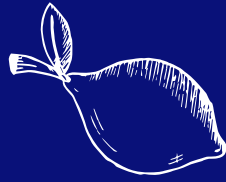
